Sumping Re-Starts After Positive Review

Bounty is now re-starting sumping operations at Cook Colliery following a positive review of the sumping process. The review was completed 4 days earlier than expected due to a dedicated effort from all mine and Mines Inspectorate staff. I would like to thank the Queensland Mines Inspectorate for their support during the review process.

All crews are ready, and all equipment and systems are in place for an immediate return to high productivity mining.

A further boost to production will be the addition of two electric trucks (shuttle cars) which will also be delivered to site over the coming week.
